Come join us on May 4, 2024 for an opportunity to get together and discuss how things work and get done for LNRW. We'll start with a **Training** exercise, where each of us get a chance to present “Emergency Traffic” and serve as Net Control during a series of Simulated Safety Nets.

We will also discuss **Operations** where we'll discuss communicating with the Office of Emergency Services, using Apps like CodeRed or WatchDuty, examine ideas for calling the safety net into action at times other than Wednesday Evening, and discuss our web site and how it works.

Finally, we'll discuss **Planning** where we will talk about future expansion of our coverage area, improving signal quality by using our mobile units to survey reception in the neighborhood, linking of the repeater #1 and #2, and how external players such as AT&T dropping land line services in California affects our operations.

We will be providing coffee, water, tea, and some sort of snack to tied you over through lunch. You will not need to bring your radios, unless you have questions about its operations. The Simulated Safety Net is a round the table exercise.

Feel free to invite your neighbors and friends, this workshop is an opportunity for potential new members and other interested parties to learn what LNRW is all about.
